Prophecy and Promise

This term in Nursery, our topic is "Prophecy and Promise." We will be exploring the wonderful story of Jesus' birth, learning about the special promises made before He was born and the joyful events that took place in the stable at Bethlehem. The



children will discover who came to visit baby Jesus, including the shepherds and the wise men, through stories, songs, role play, and creative activities. It will be a lovely opportunity for the children to reflect on the true meaning of Christmas and to share in the excitement and wonder of this very special story.

Learning in Nursery

In Autumn 2, our nursery children will enjoy a rich and engaging curriculum designed to spark curiosity and creativity. We will explore Bonfire Night, learning about its traditions and safety and celebrate Nursery Rhyme Week with fun songs and rhymes that develop listening and speaking skills. We will also reflect on Remembrance Sunday, understanding the importance of remembrance and respect. We will begin to introduce the children to phonics with a focus on environmental sounds, helping them to tune into the world around them. They will also have the opportunity to explore Spanish in a playful way and practice early numeracy skills through counting activities. As we approach the festive season, we will begin the start of Advent, introducing simple traditions and activities. Children will continue to strengthen their fine motor skills through Dough Disco and Squiggle While You Wiggle and develop coordination and energy with Zumba sessions.
