RE- Desert to Garden

In this half term, as we begin Lent and begin to look forward to Easter, our RE theme is 'Desert to Garden'. The children will hear and learn about the stories of Jesus in the desert, Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, Death on the Cross and Resurrection. They will learn about Lent as a time when we prepare and get ready for Easter.

This is a time when we reflect on our lives and on how the things we do affect the lives of others. It is difficult for young children to realise that we are all capable of hurting others and to know that when we do so we should feel sorry and try to be kind.

They will begin to understand that Jesus forgave those who hurt him and teaches us to forgive people who hurt us.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to recognise when they have hurt someone. It is particularly difficult for young children to grasp the idea that someone's *feelings* can be hurt.
- Giving gentle reminders to say sorry in times of conflict, taking time to talk things over quietly so that your child thinks about what has happened.
- Encouraging your child to give some small gift to a charitable cause and explain to them what the charity does to help people.
- Going to Sunday Mass. Mass at All Saints Church (Saturday evening 5pm or Sunday 9.30am.) At Sunday morning Mass there is also Little Church that the children can go to and listen to the Gospel with their friends. We would love to see you!
