

English

Our first story will be `The Incredible Book Eating Boy`. The children will then write a letter to Henry. They will think about questions they can include in the letter and learn how the letter is structured.

Finally, the children will learn the poem `Monkey See Monkey Do` and create their own poem. They will learn about rhythms, rhymes and repetition.

Our Whole Class Reader is Mr Penguin and The Lost Treasure

Science

Our topic is `Plants`. The children will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. They will research and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Computing

The children will learn all about the International Space Station as part of our data handling topic. They will learn what data is and the different ways that it can be represented as well as developing an understanding of why data is useful, how it can be used and ways in which it can be gathered and recorded both by humans and computers.

DT

Our topic is all about `Cooking and Nutrition: Balanced Diet`. The children will learn about the main food groups and identify foods that belong to each group. They will describe the taste, feel and smell of a given food.

Finally, the children will construct a wrap that meets the design brief and their plan.

Religion

Our R.E. topic this half term is `Dialogue & Encounter` The children will learn all about the Good Samaritan, the different stages of Mass, the wider Christian community and begin to explore Judaism.



Music

Our topic `Structure: Myths and Legends`. The children will develop an understanding of structure by exploring and ordering rhythms.

PSHE

Our theme in PSHE is `Journey in Love`. The children will learn about growing up and how we have to look after ourselves.

Maths

Multiplication and Division – doubling, halving, quotative and partitive division

The children will further embed their knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Particularly focusing on the relation between multiplication and division.

Position and Direction

The children will learn how to use positional and directional language. They will focus on up, down, left, right, clockwise and anticlockwise.

Sense of Measure- Capacity, Volume and Mass.

The children compare and order length, mass, volume and capacity. They will learn to choose the appropriate standard measure for length, temperature and capacity.

Geography

The children will explore our local area and compare it to a small village in Trinidad. They will use map, photos, videos and walks to find out as much as we can about our local area. They will compare the similarities and differences.

PE

Our PE Days will be on a **Tuesday** and a **Friday**. The children will come to school in their PE kits. The children will learn all about team-building and tennis.
