

English

Phonics: The children will continue to follow the Read Write Inc scheme for phonics. Phonics will be delivered daily. The children will read books daily that are closely matched to their increasing knowledge of phonics and tricky words.

Writing: We will practise hand writing every day learning correct letter formation in preparation for cursive hand writing.

Science

This term our topic is Animals, Including Humans. We will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, look at how animals can be grouped and what they eat. We will continue looking at the seasons and how they are changing as we move through Autumn.

PE

Our PE Days will be on a Monday and Thursday. The children will come to school in their PE kits. On the Monday, children will learn about invasion games and on Thursday children will be taught a dance.

PSHE

Our theme in PSHE is Health and Wellbeing. We will be describing feels and emotions, looking at relaxation techniques that can help manage difficult emotions. We will also be looking at bedtime routines, hand washing and the understanding that germs spread via our hands.

Computing

Our focus will be learning how to recognise cause and effect when pressing buttons on a Bee-Bot. Learning to programme a Bee-Bot, giving several clear instructions, recoding a video demonstrating our new knowledge of Bee-Bots and identifying and correcting any mistakes in their programming.



Music

Tempo, Snail and Mouse: We will be using our bodies and instruments to listen and respond to pieces of music with fast and slow speeds. We will also learn a rhyme and a song focusing on fast and slow.

D&T

This term the children will be learning about different ways to join fabric together. We will be designing a puppet using a template, decorating the puppet to match our designs and evaluating our work.

Maths

This unit focuses on subtraction within 10. Children are introduced to formal subtraction for the first time. They will be introduced to the key language of subtraction and a range of scenarios where subtraction takes place. We will also move on to solving word problems with addition and subtraction. Finally, we cover 2D and 3D shapes. Children will learn to name the different shapes and identify the features that determine how they are classified.

History

We will look at how we learnt to fly. We look at important events surrounding the history of flight and how these events have changed the lives of others. We will also look at people and events in the past linked to flight.

Religion

Prophecy and Promise: This unit includes The Annunciation, Mary's visit to Elizabeth, Mary our Mother, The birth of Jesus, and the shepherds visiting Jesus following his birth.

French

Children will continue to learn french through songs and games with our foreign language assistant.
