

**English** This term year 3 will be reading, 'Charlotte's Web' by E.B.White. We are looking forward to learning about the characters, setting and plot. We've already studied the front cover and the blurb to make our own predictions! We will go on to write stories about, 'Stone Age Boy' and a report all about trolls! By the end of the term, Year 3 will become performance poets.

**History** This term we will be focusing on the question 'Would you prefer to have lived in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age'. Children will learn how people lived in prehistoric Britain and use evidence to explain how life changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

**Where is God in our Learning?** God is at the heart of everything we do, and each subject offers an opportunity to see His presence more clearly. In Science, as we study animals and humans we will marvel at God's creation. In English, as we learn to write stories, we will reflect on the stories in the Bible and what they have taught us and how we can use them to reflect and grow. Our PSHE this term will allow us to consider carefully our relationships and how God first loved us so we can love one another.

**Our Year 3 Stewardship Mission:** As part of our stewardship mission, Year 3 will be taking care of our school by litter picking. We are looking forward to looking after God's world and thanking God for this mission.

**Spanish** We are all really excited to learn how to speak Spanish this term. Year 3 will begin by learning some greetings and developing their simple conversational skills.

**Art** Our art topic this term is 'Growing Artists.' We will begin by observing shape in the natural and man-made environment very closely.

**Science** In our science lessons we are going to be learning all about animals including humans. Our scientific knowledge will be developed in the areas of the human skeleton, animal skeletons, human muscles and the five food groups.

**Computing** This Autumn term our Year 3 pupils will be learning about programming and coding. They will design, write and debug programs that accomplish specific goals including controlling or stimulating physical systems.

## Autumn 1: Creation and Covenant



**Religion** Year 3 will be deepening their knowledge and understanding of creation and covenant. We will encounter the belief that humans are made in the image of God and talk about what this might mean. Through prayer, reflection and curiosity we will explore God's glory in creation and express our praise and gratitude.

**Maths** This term our Year 3 pupils are learning to add and subtract across 10. We will be developing knowledge and understanding of numbers to 1000 and learning about bridging 100.

**PSHE** We will be planning for a healthy lifestyle including physical activity, rest and diet. As part of this we will explore a range of relaxation stretches, develop different aspects of our identity and understand the benefits of healthy eating and dental hygiene.

**Music** We will first be learning to sing in time with others, recognise simple rhythmic notation and compose a Viking battle song.
