### **Incident at Dainwell Park**

I'm sure many of you have been made aware of the worrying incident that was reported to have happened at Dainwell Park last night, please see the communication below which has been sent to us from Trafford.

*Two of our children were playing in Dainwell Park around 6.30pm and a woman in her late 30s, with short blonde hair, approached them. She told them she had a van around the corner, with PlayStations, music and toys in the back, and queried their ages. The parking areas can be viewed from the play area, and they couldn't see a van. The boys sensibly told her it was none of her business and left the park and went straight home. The parents reported the incident to the Police.*

During assembly this morning, I have talked to the children about always being mindful of their personal safety when they are playing out or walking home, and about avoiding strangers should they ever be approached. I'm sure you will reiterate this important message at home to help keep them all safe. This is especially important for some of our older children who are experimenting with going out without an adult and playing out later, enjoying the lighter evenings.
